## Using Code Mode inside Landing Page Editor



Things you can do:


- 1. You can Create your own style of Page Layout.

## Creating code mode inside a Landing Page.


Login into Aritic Pinpoint Dashboard>>Assets>>Landing Pages >> Design New Landing Page



2. In the next page, under Theme opt for Code Mode as shown below.



3. Once you **Select** the code mode, click on **Landing Page Studio** to start creating your customized landing page. Here you can edit and modify your Landing Page. To do modifications, you have to click on **Format Code** as shown below.



After you are done editing the HTML code, click on **Apply** to apply all your changes, and go back to the previous page where you will need to click on **Apply** >> **Save and Close** to implement all the changes.

By switching to the Code Mode, you will be able to edit the content only in HTML code. Changing back to a theme will make you lose the content.
